WHAT IS THE CAB?

The Community Action Board (CAB) is a mandated oversight board under Federal Law and generally oversees the implementation of the various social service poverty programs funded with the County's Community Services Block Grant (CSBG) allocation. The CAB was established by Board Order No. 107 on December 18, 1979.

The CAB is the Community Action Agency's tripartite Board which consists of fifteen members. Five (5) members represent the Public Sector; five (5) members represent the Low-Income Sector and, five (5) members represent the Private Sector.
